Module 1: About Me:

Questo modulo è stato affrontato come ripasso.

FUNCTIONS:

The house, possessions, dates, family, describing people (physical appearance), likes and dislikes, agreeing and disagreeing, daily activities, the time, lifestyles.

GRAMMAR:

Be, Have got, present simple (all forms) like + -ing, possessive case, possessive adjectives, adjectives order, qualifiers, verb with - ing form, which, what, connectors, object pronouns (all types), prepositions of time, adverbs and expressions of frequency.

VOCABULARY:

Rooms and furniture, personal possessions, dates, months, ordinal numbers, festivals, the family, physical description, types of music, sports and free time activities, daily activities, jobs, days of the week.

Module 2: Meeting Up:

FUNCTIONS: talking about: present activities on the phone, temporary actions, food and quantity, making requests and offers, suggestions and abilities.

GRAMMAR: present continuous (all forms), time expressions, countable and uncountable nouns, *how much, how many, there is, there are, some, any, a few, little, (too) much, many, a lot of, lots of, not enough. Would you like, want, let's, shall we, what about, how about + ing, would prefer, would rather, can, could, may*, prepositions of place.

VOCABULARY: everyday activities, personal life, school, food, drink and diet, quantifiers, cardinal numbers, meals, abilities, places.

Module 3: Going Places:

FUNCTIONS: Talking about past events, (holidays, using public transport), asking about possessions, asking for and giving directions, making comparisons and expressing preferences, shopping for clothes, describing clothes.

GRAMMAR: past simple regular and irregular verbs (all forms) past time expressions, interrogative pronoun *how long*, present simple (future use), subject \ object questions *who, what*, sequencers, *every, some, any, no* compounds, *whose*,



possessive pronouns, imperative, prepositions of places and movement, comparative and superlative adjectives, past continuous (all forms)

VOCABULARY: Holiday, accomodation, means of tranport, adjectives of opinion, british money, buildings, shops and places, directions, the city and the country, clothes and fashion.

Module 4: Good Times:

FUNCTIONS: Talking about future intentions, making and talking about arrangements, describing personality, the weather, making sure predictions, talking about experiences, comparing experiences, making offers of help and accepting\refusing offers.

GRAMMAR: *be going to* (future intentions), present continuous: present arrangements, future time expressions, *what's she like? what does she like?*, qualifiers (*not enough, a little bit, fairly, pretty*). False friends (semplici e più comuni), *I'll...*, and *Shall I/We...?* Offers. *Will* (1) : spontaneous decisions

VOCABULARY: lifes choices and ambitions, personality adjectives, compass point, regular and irregular past participles.
